3. (a) Describe **seven** sources of pictures. [14 marks]  
(b) Discuss **three** factors that determine the pictures used by a picture editor. [6 marks]
4. Describe the direct and oblique approaches to headline writing including **two** examples of each to support your description. [20 marks]
5. (a) Describe the **two** general types of law which affect newspapers. [4 marks]  
(b) Describe the following areas of the law of which a publication must be aware:  
(i) Contempt of court [8 marks]  
(ii) Privilege [8 marks]
6. (a) Explain what is meant by the term caption, using **two** examples to support your explanation. [8 marks]  
(b) Discuss **four** factors that must be considered when writing captions. [12 marks]
7. Explain **ten** reasons for a news story to be rejected, using examples to support your explanation. [20 marks]
8. Explain the importance of each of the following in headline writing including examples to support your explanation:  
(a) Location [5 marks]  
(b) Personal touch [5 marks]  
(c) Taste [5 marks]  
(d) Time [5 marks]
